efas NEWSLETTER

efas CONFERENCE

The conference is held each year during the fourth quarter. The research forum provides a platform for young scholars to present their research work. The conference also includes the *efas* Prize for Young Scholars, which is awarded to a young female scholar for outstanding work on a degree thesis.

efas Prize for Young Scholars

The *efas* Prize for Young Scholars is awarded annually to female graduates for outstanding theses in the economic sciences with a specific focus on Women's and Gender Studies. The prize was established in 2008 in remembrance of Professor Angela Fiedler, co-founder of the *efas* network and former coordinator of the headquarters. The prizewinner is given the opportunity to contribute an article about her work in the following *efas* newsletter.

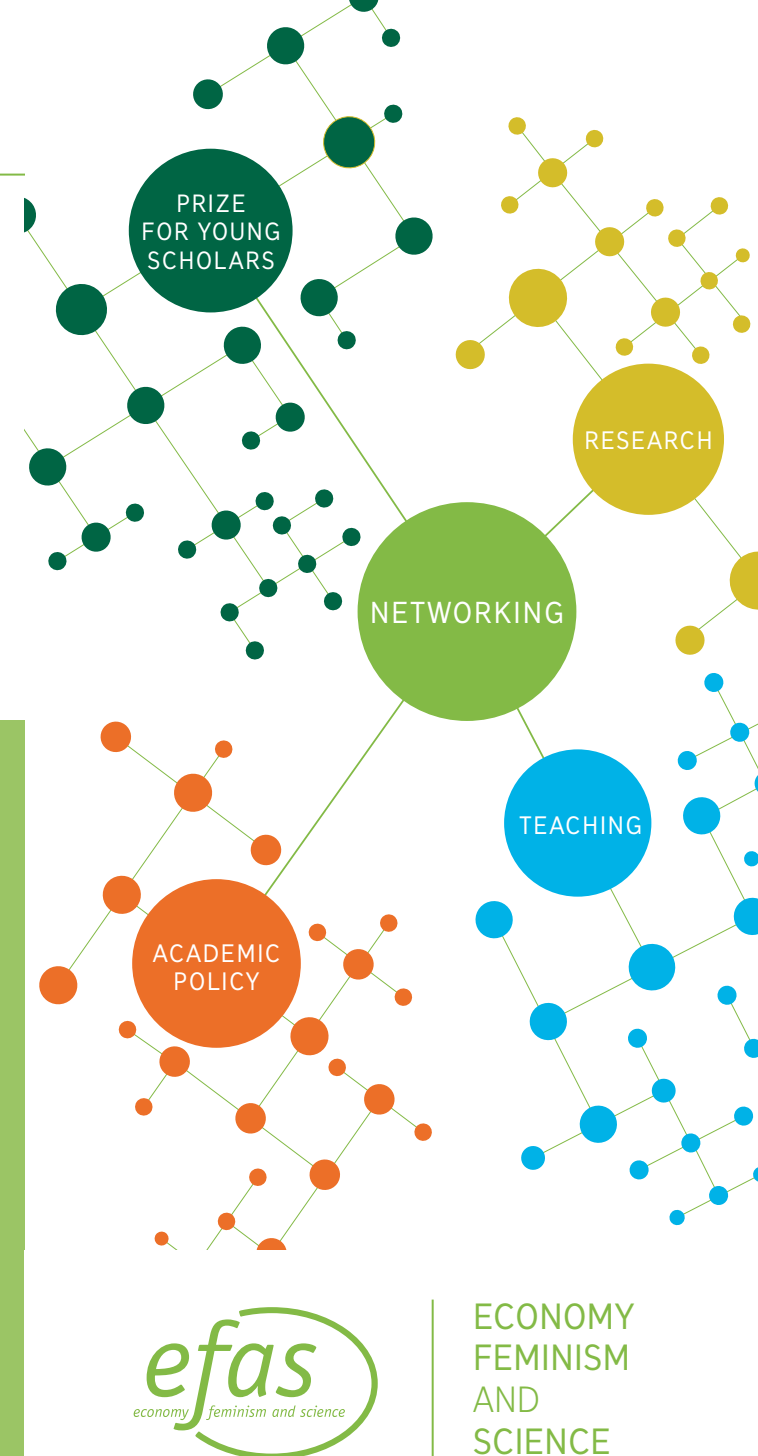
