


- Unpaid work needs to be done to secure basic needs



Current and Future Work on Time and Income Poverty

- Extended income
 - Unpaid work benefits household consumption
 - Equivalence scales
 - Replacement cost
- Application to US Panel Study of Income Dynamics
 - Less people under BRPL using extended income
- Specify thresholds and substitutability between time and money
 - Non-substitutable minima
 - Substitutability between unpaid work, leisure and money
- Mathematical tool to model a three-dimensional poverty line
